A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD CO-SPONSORING THE HARVEY MILK COMMEMORATIVE STAMP CAMPAIGN

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, The International Court Council has taken initiative in the national Harvey Milk Commemorative Stamp campaign with a letter writing campaign to the Citizen's Stamp Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, The Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee selects up to 25 stamps each year from over 50,000 proposals; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Harvey Milk Commemorative Stamp campaign is to advocate for the adoption of the Harvey Milk Commemorative Stamp on May 22, 2010 in recognition of the 80th birthday of Harvey Milk; and

WHEREAS, when the committee receives many suggestions for a particular stamp, it is more likely to be adopted; and

WHEREAS, this cause originated from the Human Relations Commission of San Diego, with a proposal sent from the 51st District Representative Bob Filner, City Council President Kevin Faulconer and Nicole Murray-Ramirez, recommending that Harvey Milk be honored on a U.S. postage stamp; and

WHEREAS, the City's co-sponsorship of the Harvey Milk Commemorative Stamp Campaign is consistent with existing City policy and advocacy for human rights:
